Registration Open

Registration for the 2023 box lacrosse season opened up on January 1st. If you haven't yet registered your player, please do so soon!

Registration this season will only be online again through RAMP. To register your player, please login to your RAMP account from last year by following this <u>link</u>:

If you do not have a RAMP account, you can follow the <u>registration link</u> to create a new account.

The ALA insurance requirements must be met for any player to be allowed on the floor. Which means your player must be registered with our club to use our floor times.

For player registration you can pay online by credit card or by sending money through an EFT (NO cheques). The EFT must be received within 24 hours to complete your registration. Failure to do so may result in loss of registration.

* A 3% processing fee will be added to your credit card on all registrations.

If sending money through EFT please ensure you add a comment with your players first and last name and the level they play.

'A' DIVISION EXPECTATION AGREEMENT

Sherwood Park Titans Lacrosse Club wants participation in team sports to be fun for all and needs support from both parents and players to achieve this goal. We provide this lacrosse program so children can be given opportunities to fully achieve their lacrosse potential in an organized and competitive environment. One such initiative is to ensure the competitiveness of the "A" level teams. All players and parents participating in the "A" programs must adhere to our club's expectations. Should you and your child wish to participate at the "A" level, you will need to sign the agreement.

EXPECTATIONS:

- Attend all practices and be on time as practicable
- Attend all games and be on time as practicable.
- Attend at least 85% of additional practices and games
- Participate in all tournaments (as chosen by the team)
- Participate in Provincials

Failure to abide by these expectations, will permit the coach of the team to adjust playing time to reward those players who show commitment to the team's success.

Drop-Ins

These drop-in floor times are for players to come out and shake the dust off, and flex their throwing arm and just get back into the lacrosse groove!

If you will be trying out for an 'A' level team or attending evaluations for parity, these drop-ins are a great way to warm-up and prepare.

Drop-ins are also for brand new players to come learn more about the game and the skills needed to become a next level lacrosse player - bring a friend with you!

There is a small fee of \$5 per drop-in, to be paid upon arrival in CASH only.

*Please come in full equipment when possible. Minimum equipment required: helmet, runners, and stick and gloves.
